

CALLED SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

**Wynne, Arkansas
January 4, 2011**

Roll Call	<p>A called meeting of the school board was held on Tuesday, January 4, 2011. The following were present: Dr. Gene Boeckmann, Dr. Neall Jackson, Mr. Spencer Parker, and Dr. Benjamin Perry, Superintendent. Mr. Melvin Taylor and Mrs. Carol Brown were unable to attend. The following individuals were also present: Mrs. Shelia Graham, Parent; Ms. Jayda Franklin, Curtis Franklin, Jr., Wynne High School Student; Mr. Keith Watson, Wynne High School Principal and Mr. Steve Morris, Wynne High School Asst. Principal.</p>
Curtis Franklin, Jr.	<p>A hearing was held on a recommendation from the superintendent to expel Curtis Franklin, a student at Wynne High School, for the remainder of the third quarter of the 2010-11 school year. Curtis was suspended for 10 days or until the Board of Education could meet to take action on the recommendation of the superintendent.</p> <p>The parent of Curtis Franklin, Jr., Mrs. Sheila McDaniel Graham attended the meeting and requested the hearing be closed.</p> <p>A recommendation was made by the superintendent to expel Curtis Franklin, Jr. from Wynne School District for the remainder of the third quarter of the 2010-11 school year.</p> <p>A motion was made by Dr. Jackson, seconded by Mr. Parker, and passed unanimously for the expulsion of Curtis Franklin, Jr. from the Wynne School District for the remainder of the third quarter of the 2010-11 school year as recommended by the superintendent.</p>
Termination of Employment: Delois Evans	<p>A hearing was held to discuss the termination of employment for Mrs. Delois Evans.</p> <p>Mrs. Delois Evans was contacted but did not attend the hearing.</p> <p>The superintendent recommended to the board to terminate the employment of Mrs. Delois Evans from the Wynne School District due to Mrs. Evans' inability to perform the duties and responsibilities of her job as a custodian due to medical related issues. Mrs. Evans has exhausted all sick leave, vacation days and her Family Medical Leave based on FMLA Policy 8.23 and is unable to return to work at full capacity. The Board of Education has the authority to terminate the employment of the employee who is unable to perform and fulfill the duties and responsibility of their contract.</p> <p>A motion was made by Mr. Parker, seconded by Dr. Jackson and passed unanimously to terminate the contract of Mrs. Delois Evans effective January 4, 2011.</p>

Resignation	<p>The superintendent recommended to the board to accept the resignation of Mrs. Brenda Shempert, Wynne High School Secretary, effective January 14, 2011.</p> <p>A motion was made by Dr. Jackson and seconded by Mr. Parker and passed unanimously to accept the resignation of Mrs. Brenda Shempert effective January 14, 2011.</p>
