Roll Call	<p>A called meeting of the school board was held on Wednesday, October 6, 2010, to discuss and obtain board approval to submit the Wynne School District's 2010-2011 Academic Comprehensive School Improvement Plan (ACSIP) to the Arkansas Department of Education for review and final approval.</p> <p>The following board members were present: Mrs. Carol Brown, Mr. Spencer Parker, Dr. Neall Jackson and Dr. Benjamin Perry, Superintendent. Board Members absent were: Mr. Gene Boeckmann and Mr. Melvin Taylor. Also present: Mrs. Kathy Lee, Assistant Superintendent Elementary and Mr. Carl Easley, Assistant Superintendent Secondary.</p>
Approval of Arkansas Comprehensive School Improvement Plan	<p>The Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent, Kathy Lee, discussed with the board the Wynne School District's Arkansas Comprehensive Improvement Plan (ACSIP). The ACSIP for the Wynne School District highlighted academic goals and objectives to be accomplished by the district such as: district-wide staff development plans and financial obligations to meet those goals and objectives, district personnel assigned to meet those goals and objectives; and how federal and state dollars such as Title I, II and III allocations along with the state's National School Lunch Allowance (NSLA) will be utilized to meet the identified academic and staff development goals and objectives of the district.</p> <p>The overall arching purpose of ACSIP is a research based academic improvement plan to assist and act as a guide to the Wynne School District in helping the district meet the federal and state goals of No Child Left Behind (NCLB) by; (1) using longitudinal data systems to improve instruction (2) increasing teacher effectiveness and (3) providing intensive support and intervention to students in lower performing schools.</p> <p>A motion was made by Mrs. Carol Brown, seconded by Dr. Neall Jackson and passed unanimously to accept the district's Arkansas Comprehensive School Improvement Plan and give consent for the Wynne School District to forward the Arkansas Comprehensive School Improvement Plan to the Arkansas Department of Education for final approval.</p>
